














# FRIENDS of NATIONAL SERVICE AWARDS

# PARTNERING TO PROTECT AND EXPAND NATIONAL SERVICE

Voices for National Service is a coalition of national, state and local service organizations working together to build bipartisan support for national service, develop policies to expand and strengthen service opportunities for all Americans, and to ensure a robust federal investment in the Corporation for National and Community Service (operating as AmeriCorps).

Voices for National Service was founded in 2003 in the wake of a successful campaign to save AmeriCorps from sudden and significant proposed cuts. The national service field organized and launched a successful "Save AmeriCorps" campaign that ultimately restored--and in fact increased--federal funding for AmeriCorps within one year. Following the successful 2003 Save AmeriCorps campaign, the national service community established Voices for National Service, a permanent field-based coalition dedicated to protecting and growing the federal investment in national service.

City Year serves as the organizational and operational host of Voices for National Service and the coalition's work is guided by a Steering Committee of CEOs of service organizations and leaders of state service commissions. The work of Voices for National Service is made possible through membership dues, philanthropic grants and gifts, and annual support from co-chairs and members of Voices for National Service's Business Council and Champions Circle.
