

## Template - Letter to the Editor (LTE) (Updated February 6, 2025)

Letters to the editor (LTE) are widely read not only by members of Congress and their staff, but also the general public, newspaper editors and reporters, and other opinion leaders. An LTE that speaks to a broader audience, and underscores AmeriCorps' vital importance to the local community, is a great way to get your legislator's attention <u>and</u> garner more public support.
